

BHS Treasurers report for 2017

I am glad to say that it was financially a uneventful year for the Beaulieu History Society and that the financial situation of the society continues to be very sound. The committee would also like to thank Adam Mills for reviewing the accounts and they can now be found on the Beaulieu History Society's web site.

Subscriptions were £816 in 2017 compared to £1016 the previous year. We also generously received £750 from the Common Good Fund to help pay for our publication costs and the sale of books in 2017 was £780.

In expenses during 2017 the cost of setting out the book, Beaulieu in Tudor and Stewart Times, was £1375.

Excess Income over expenditure was £553 compared with £1031 the previous year. This surplus meant the Bank balance on December 31st 2017 was £5131 compared to £4577 the previous year.
