

BHS Treasurers report for 2019

I am glad to say that it was financially a uneventful year for the Beaulieu History Society and that the financial situation of the society continues to be very sound. The committee would also like to thank Adam Mills for reviewing the accounts and they can now be found on the Beaulieu History Society's web site.

Subscriptions were £881 in 2019 compared to £946 in 2018 and £816 in 2017. It is worth mentioning that the subscriptions were higher in 2019 due to the fact that we had quite a few temporary guest members at two of the talks.

The main expense during 2019 was the coach for the trip to Titchfield but this was mainly covered by the generous donation from the Common Good Fund which is in the previous year's financial statement.

Excess Income over expenditure was £462 compared minus £391.50 the previous year. The Bank balance on December 31st 2019 was £5,202 compared to £4,739.50 the previous year.
